“With our continued business growth and movement towards a nomadic working environment. Our goal was to consolidate line of business applications to be managed from a single IT office. The preferred delivery was using Citrix technology, however being regulated by the FSA, we required strong authentication to be in place. “The Citrix environment at iimia required a solution that could easily integrate. First investigation showed RSA and Secure Computing had inbuilt Citrix agents. These seemed the ideal choices, however the realisation of having to manage and deploy hardware tokens was too resource intensive, coupled with the fact that the user database was completely separate from our existing Microsoft Active Directory. This meant additional administration overhead was required to keep all user databases in sync with each other. Secure Computing AD plug-in, did not give the real time integration that was first envisaged and was removed from the selection process”. Comments Doug Ritchie Group IT Manager

The solution from SecurEnvoy gave Midas Capital the flexibility to provide a seamless deployment for our remote user base. The fact that we could use the existing Microsoft password as the PIN component resolved any PIN management and deployment issues. In addition the Security team felt that a complex 8 character password that changed every 30 days was immensely stronger than a 4 digit PIN.

Integration with Citrix Access Gateway (CAG) and Presentation Server was straight forward. The user experience was simplified by allowing a single sign on to back-end applications. This could be accomplished as the SecurEnvoy configuration allowed the Microsoft password to be the PIN.
