SMS Gateway Routing

SMS gateways have the ability to dynamically route to country specific or International destinations. By utilising 'intelligent routing', companies avoid expensive roaming charges when communicating internationally, as SMS requests are automatically routed either via a modem or the Web based SMS provider.

Migration

Customers moving from tokens or passwords to a SecurEnvoy system have the ability to choose the pace of their migration. Authentication requests from both SecurAccess and legacy systems are handled through the same interface

Migrating Passwords

SecurAccess has built in migration support to facilitate an easy move from existing passwords to a SecurEnvoy 2FA solution. User's who still have a password can access the same resources with no further configuration changes. SecurEnvoy only requires licenses for migrated users, which is an additional cost saving.

Migrating legacy Tokens

SecurAccess fully supports migration from third party token servers (such as RSA, Vasco etc). Third party tokens that are already deployed can be supported until such time that they expire or are retired. User's who still have an existing third party token can access the same resources with no service interruption. Thereby leveraging your existing investment in token technology.

Windows Server 2008 R2 Terminal services Web

Microsoft new Web based terminal services (TSWEB) for 2008 is the key business enabler for remote workers, SecurEnvoy's latest release now supports authenticating TSWEB across all Windows 2008 platforms including the newly released R2 server.

Windows Server 2003 Terminal services

Microsoft 2003 Terminal servers are now fully supported with SecurEnvoy's latest Windows logon agent.

Windows Logon Agent

SecurEnvoy's Windows logon agent brings 2FA to Microsoft Windows server and XP environments. Customers who wish to provide a 2FA to the desktop or console now have the ability to fully secure their server access or desktop environments.

Syslog

Enterprises, who wish to maintain a central repository of all Security events, can now leverage SecurEnvoy ability to send authentication information and server healthcare to any Syslog server.

Multi Language support

SecurEnvoy can now support county specific languages upon the LDAP server. Usernames in any language are now catered for including such variants as Hebrew etc.



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
